St Albans Folk Festival: 16th June

Tutor Showcase	All tutors will give a short performance in the festival showcase. We are intending to find a venue for the morning in which the team can prepare for this performance.

Ceilidh Project	Workshops will run on Saturday and Sunday. The format incorporates two 1hr workshops each day: one with a dance focus (calling and dance writing), and the other a music focus as well as a rehearsal on Sunday afternoon. The showcase will be a 'DIY ceilidh' on the Sunday with tutees having the opportunity to be in the band or call a dance.
Craft	The format will be two 1.5hr sessions, with the aim for tutees to make something that they can take away. The lead tutor will decide what this will be, and teach the core and trainee tutors the necessary skills.

Craft	Craft tutors will only need to run activities on Craft Day, which will be on Sunday 5th August from 10am-5pm
Band/Theater/ Dance	Lead tutors will run a taster session on Sunday 5th, and the main workshops will run Mon-Fri. On Friday 10th band and theatre will have a showcase at the Manor Pavillion, and dance will have a performance tour of the seafront.
Open Mic/ Young Performers	The schedule for this strand is open to suggestions but will definitely include 2x open mics (one afternoon and one evening) and 2x young performers workshops (afternoon), aimed at increasing confidence and performance skills. Some performers from the open mic may be offered the opportunity to perform a solo/small group piece in the Friday showcase.

Festival Choir (all ages)	Two 1.5hr workshops for all ages, one on Saturday and one on Sunday. Showcase TBC.
Youth Band	Two 1.5hr workshops, one on Saturday and one on Sunday. We are also running an open mic on the Sunday afternoon, which band tutors will be asked to contribute to. There is no formal showcase for participants, but they will be given priority to perform in the open mic.
